

- Esplanade Park/Senate Square Stroll along historical Esplanade and visit the Senate Square. The Cathedral an Iconic Landmark. Built during the Russian rule as a tribute to Czar Nicholas I. Open from 9:00, times vary. Free Entrance. Visit Helsinki City Museum. Free Entrance. Change Group money exchange at Pohjoisesplanadi 21.
- Katajanokka Explore historical Katajanokka district and visit Uspenski Cathedral. Discover Helsinki from top of SkyWheel Helsinki. Experience Helsinki´s sights and attractions in the amazing multisensory show at Flying Cinema Tour Of Helsinki.
- Market Square/Havis Amanda Take the Royal Line Sightseeing Cruise from Market Square to see the beautiful archipelago (1½ h). Enjoy the atmosphere of the open-air market, try to keep your ice cream safe from seagulls. Havis Amanda Famous female statue sculpted in 1906. Visit the Old Market Hall.
- Olympia Terminal/Mannerheim Museum Ferries to Stockholm and Riga terminal built for the 1952 Olympics. Museum dedicated to Gustaf Mannerheim, Marshal of Finland.
- Eira/Kaivopuisto Park Beautiful neighborhood with jugend style houses and embassies. Visit popular and elegant Café Carusel. Take a walk in beautiful Kaivopuisto Park Popular picnic place for locals. Take a stroll up to the Observatory hill and enjoy the spectacular sea view.
- 6 Hernesaari Bay offers cafés, restaurants, terraces and traditional Finnish Sauna Löyly with unique architecture.
- Hietalahti Flea Market/Market Hall Charming flea market at the Hietalahti Market Square and traditional covered food market.

- Kamppi Visit Helsinki Art Museum at Tennispalatsi (Tennis Palace), Kamppi Shopping Centre and Natural History Museum.
- **9** Rock Church Discover the most unique church in Finland, built into the bedrock. Explore the impressive interior. Open from 10:00, times vary. Entrance fee 4 €.
- Sibelius Monument An impressive stainless steel monument dedicated to the famous Finnish composer Jean Sibelius. Free entrance. Enjoy a cup of coffee with a delicious cinnamon bun in the quaint Café Regatta by the seaside. Töölö district has many trendy cafes, well-reviewed restaurants and small shops, and is full of Nordic classicism buildings. Explore Helsinki´s past at the Tram Museum. Free entrance.
- **Olympic Stadium** Take a picture of the Olympic Stadium and its tower. The Stadium is closed for renovations until August.
- SeaLife/Linnanmäki Short walk to Sea Life Helsinki and Linnanmäki Amusement Park.
 Take a stroll along the shores of Töölö Bay and visit Helsinki City Botanic Garden.
- Parliament/National Museum The Parliament of Finland. Explore the history of Finland at the National Museum. Visit the Helsinki Music Centre and Central Library Oodi.
- City Centre/Lasipalatsi A good spot for shopping Forum Shopping Centre and
- Makia clothing company's Flagship Store. Visit Hard Rock Cafe Helsinki.
- Swedish Theatre Visit Stockmann Department Store and shop for Finnish design along the Esplanade shopping street. Short walking distance to Design Museum Helsinki.
