



- 1 Senate Square** Stroll across Senate Square and visit Helsinki Cathedral. An iconic landmark, built during the Russian era as a tribute to Czar Nicholas I
- 2 Katajanokka** Explore historical Katajanokka district and visit Uspenski Cathedral. Discover Helsinki from the top of SkyWheel Helsinki
- 3 Havis Amanda** See the famous female statue sculpted in 1906 and visit the Old Market Hall
- 4 Olympia Terminal** Ferries to Stockholm and Riga – terminal built for 1952 Olympics. Visit the museum dedicated to Gustaf Mannerheim, Marshal of Finland.
- 5 Kaivopuisto Park** one of the oldest and best known parks in Helsinki
- 6 Compass square** Town Square with great views across the water
- 7 Eira** Neighbourhood known for its stately, Jugend style manor homes
- 8 Hernesaari Cruise Terminal LHB/C (for cruise ships)** Easy pick-up and drop off for Cruise ship passengers
- 9 Hernesaari Cruise Terminal LHD (for cruise ships)** Easy pick-up and drop off for Cruise ship passengers
- 10 Hernesaari Seaside** Offers cafés, restaurants, terraces and traditional Finnish Sauna Löyly with unique architecture
- 11 Hietalahti Market Hall** Charming flea market at the Hietalahti Market Square and traditional covered food market
- 12 Bulevardi** This boulevard is lined with restaurants, cafes and art galleries. Visit the Old Church, the oldest existing church in Helsinki dating back to 1826.

- 13 Kamppi** Visit Helsinki Art Museum at Tennispalatsi, Kamppi Shopping Centre and the Natural History Museum
- 14 Rock Church** Discover the most unique church in Finland, built into the bedrock
- 15 Sibelius Monument** An impressive stainless steel monument dedicated to famous Finnish composer Jean Sibelius
- 16 Töölö** City district with many trendy cafes, well-reviewed restaurants and small shops, and is full of Nordic classicism buildings
- 17 Olympic Stadium** Take a picture of the Olympic Stadium and its tower
- 18 City Botanic Garden** Take a stroll along the shores of Töölö Bay and visit Helsinki City Botanic Garden
- 19 Parliament / National Museum** Visit the parliament of Finland, explore the history of Finland at the National Museum. Also fun to visit here: Helsinki Music Centre and the Central Library Oodi
- 20 City Centre / Lasipalatsi** Forum Shopping Centre and Makia clothing company's flagship store are great places to go shopping
- 21 Swedish Theatre** Visit Stockmann Department Store and see a play or musical at Finland's best theatre building
- 22 Esplanade / Market Square** Shop for Finnish design along the Esplanade shopping street. Short walk to the Design Museum Helsinki
