Large and small reef sharks as well as numerous exotic, colourful fish swim together in the 30 meter long aquarium that holds 1.2 million liters of water. At the aquarium you can see the Sandbar Shark, one of the biggest coastal sharks in the world easily distinguishable by its very high first dorsal fin.



The roof construction of Ericsson Globe was reinforced with 42 tons of steel and then mounted a further 70 tonnes of rails.
